## Bluebird Nest Box Project - Box Location Data Sheet

### Useful information for filling in the data sheets:

#### Species you are likely to see:

**Eastern Bluebird:** Bird has blue back, brown on chest and white on belly. Nest of soft grasses.

**Tree Swallow:** Bird has iridescent blue back, all white on chest and belly. Nest of grasses lined with feathers.

**Black-capped Chickadee:** Head with black cap that covers most of eye, body is black and white. Nest of moss and fine plant material lined with hair.

**White-breasted Nuthatch:** Bluish feathers on back, all white on chest and belly. Nest of strips of bark, and dirt lined with finer plant material, fur, feathers and hair.

**Tufted Titmouse:** Grey bird with a crest on head. Nest constructed of leaves, moss, and grasses lined with hair & fur.

**House Wren:** Small, brown bird. Generally hold tail up in the air. Nest of twigs, lined with fine grasses, and feathers. **House Sparrow:** Brown bird, male has black markings on face and throat. Nest of grasses and litter like tissues and cellophane completely filling the box.

**European Starling:** Large glossy bird with spots on feathers. Nest constructed of sticks, grasses, paper and feathers.
